Tile Cleaning Product Usage

The following products are used in the for the completion of tile cleaning services

Chemical usage

T & G LF (Low Foam) – Alkaline tile cleaning product. Mix 4 to 1 with hot water and mop onto the tiles prior to agitation and extraction. Do not allow to dry before extraction as the product will need to be reactivated for effective removal

T & G Power – A high performance tile cleaning product designed for commercial areas, or very heavily soiled tiles where there is a high volume of cooking fats or oils. Mix 20 to 1 with warm water and apply to the affected areas

WARNING: This product is caustic and will damage metallic finishes.

Grout Restore 20 – Acidic cleaning solution. Mix 4 to 1 with hot water and mop onto tiles prior to agitation and extraction.

Grout Restore 50 - Acidic cleaning solution. Mix 4 to 1 with hot water and mop onto tiles prior to agitation and extraction. To be used only in specific situations with high levels of lime scale or efflorescence. WARNING: This product is corrosive!

Oxyboost Plus – An oxygen bleach that adds oxygen to the diluted cleaning solution that it is mixed with. Add 60 grams (2 level scoops) to 5 litres of warm, diluted LF solution. Apply to the floor within 30 mins of mixing the Oxyboost with the cleaning solution.

Chlorosan - A chlorine bleach designed to treat mould and mildew stains. Mix 10 parts water to 1 part Chlorosan and apply to the stained area. Agitate, allow to dwell and then extract.

Warning: Only use in a ventilated area and whilst wearing a respirator. Will bleach carpets.
