



Usage

Standard Floor Preparation

Mix 10:1 in a pump sprayer. Spray a heavy even coating on the floor and clean with a Polivac rotary machine (low speed) with either a maroon prep-pad or a dollar sand disc. Clean all edges with a doodlebug and detail corners by hand. Clean over with a walk behind floor scrubber with fresh hot water (use hot water from the tap — additional heating is not required).

Floor with Heavy Soiling or Wax Build Up

Mix 3:1 in a pump sprayer and apply a very heavy, even coating on the floor and allow a 10 minute dwell time. Clean with a Polivac using a maroon prep-pad. Clean over with a walk behind floor scrubber with fresh warm water. Repeat as necessary.

Wax build-up is usually evident by a varying sheen level. The floor will often be darker in the corners or edges of rooms where the build-up of wax is heaviest.



Longevity

The expected lifespan of a standard Timber Refresh service is 2-4 years, after which the client may choose to have the floors "refreshed again".

Curing Times

- Ready to walk on and gently replace the furniture in one hour
- 95% cured in 24 hours
- 100% cured in 72 hours

Avoid wet-mopping the floor, do not replace rugs and minimise pets (especially large dogs) for 3 days from application.

Usage

Mix with **Crosslinker M** at a ratio of 50ml crosslinker to 1 litre of Timber Refresh

Timber Refresh: 1 litre per 60sqm per coat. 2 coats are required (mix 1 litre of product per 30 sqm of timber refresh service).

Timber Refresh + 2: 1 litre per 60sqm per coat. 3 - 4 coats are required (mix 1 litre of product per 20 sqm of Timber Refresh + 2 service).

Timber Restore: Use as required to build up a wear layer in worn areas (usually 3 to 6 coats) and apply in accordance with a timber refresh service for areas where the coating is intact and in reasonable condition.

Timber Refresh Application Cost (with 25% wastage): \$3.01 per sqm. The cost of application with incidentals such as mopping pad, cloths, tape, booties and bag is \$3.50 per sqm

Timber Refresh + 2 Application Cost (with 25% wastage): \$4.67 per sqm Application with incidentals such as mopping pads, cloths, tape, booties and bag is \$5.30 per sqm.

Additional product usage must be allowed for a Timber Refresh + 2 service with a warm floor or when colours are added to minimise sun fading.

4 Strato Extreme High-Density Polyurethane Coating



Strato Extreme High-Density Polyurethane Coating

German-made high-density, waterborne 2-pack polyurethane coating. High performing floor coating with excellent scratch resistance.

Applied as the final coating for Timber Restore Service. Excellent bonding performance to Timber Refresh product when applied within 3 hours from the final Timber Refresh coating.

Longevity

The expected lifespan of a Timber Restore service with the Strato Extreme coating is 5 – 10 years.

Curing time

- Usually ready to walk on and gently replace the furniture in 2 – 4 hours, but up to 12 hours. Temperature, airflow and humidity will affect drying time
- 97% cured in 3 days hours
- 100% cured in 7 hours

Avoid wet-mopping for 7 days from application. Do not replace rugs for 7 days from application.

Usage

Mix with the **Crosslinker** supplied at a ratio of 100ml of **Crosslinker** to 1Litre of **Strato Extreme**. Apply at a ratio of 1 litre per 10 sqm.

Price

- \$239 per 5 litre container (with 500ml crosslinker)
- \$43.45 per litre
- \$5.21 per square metre (allowing for 20% wastage)

The costs of application including freight, rollers, brushes and tape is \$5.50 to \$6 per square metre.

Application

Apply with a 10 – 12 mm nap roller. Cut into the edges with a paintbrush. Always maintain a wet edge during application. Working over a tacky coating will result in a dull or orange peel finish.
